

Alberto Carrasquilla Barrera appointed new Board Member of Banco de la República

The new member of the Board of Directors studied economics at *Universidad de los Andes* and holds a PhD in Economy from the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign. Between 1993 and 1997, Mr. Carrasquilla was the Deputy Technical Governor at *Banco de la República*.

Alberto Carrasquilla has served twice during his professional career as Minister of the Treasury and Public Credit – the first time between 2003 and 2007 and the second time between 2018 and 2021. He also spent part of his career as Vice-Minister of the Treasury between 2002 and 2003.

He has also served as Dean of Economics at *Universidad de los Andes*, Consultant, and Lead Research Economist at the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) in Washington.
